## PASTORS CORNER

Last Sabbath I began a seven-week preaching series entitled, "The Financial Crisis and the End of Time." My beginning message for the series was entitled, "Building on the Rock in 2020" and this Sabbath's message is entitled, "January Credit Blues." Today we will be hearing from a hidden prophet in the Old Testament by the name of Habakkuk. The reason I described this prophet as hidden is that the majority of us this morning will need to look at the table of contents in our Bible if we hope to find him. Habakkuk is located in the Minor Prophets section of the Old Testament, nestled between Nahum and Zephaniah. Sadly, this latest clue may not be of help to many, but thank God once we find this little three-chapter book, we will realize that the prophet has much to say about our present financial state of affairs. Habakkuk is a message based upon two complaints and God's answers as found in the first two chapters.

Speaking of two complaints, last weekend I participated in a Grade 8 "Lock-In" at College Park Elementary School. The Grade 8 class had organized a "Lock-In" with School Board and parental approval. Complaint Number 1: Why does the Pastor after a Sabbath of preaching, visiting, and meetings have to supervise energetic Grade 8 students who never want to sleep and sleep in a school building when he has a warm and toasty bed at home? Answer: A convincing wife (take one for the team) and a Grade 8 daughter who had meticulously planned the "Lock-In" for weeks with help from classmates. Complaint Number 2: If I'm going to sleep on a classroom floor, then why can't I sleep in a little longer on Sunday morning? Answer: Why sleep in Pastor? Life is too short to miss out on the fun. The night began with class worship, followed by glow games. Do you know how hard it is to hide when you are basically glowing wherever you go? Following glow games, we enjoyed a new year's resolution diet breakers menu (ice-cream floats, chips, popcorn and cookies) while watching a movie. The late fun was only beginning as both boys and girls' adult chaperons indicated verbal and non-verbal communication lasted WAY past midnight (despite many reminders to "Shush!"). Sunday morning came soon enough as the girl's pots and pans orchestra blasted a wake-up call in the hallways outside of the boys sleeping quarters. Parental re-enforcements came Sunday morning along with pancakes, hash-browns and maple syrup and most importantly a release time from the "Lock-In." Question: Did I have fun? Answer: I was sore and sleep-deprived, but I sure did have fun!

After complaining, Habakkuk concludes his message with a prayer of thanksgiving in chapter three. "The Sovereign Lord is my strength! He makes me as surefooted as a deer, able to tread upon the heights." I too will declare that the "Lord is my strength!" but I will add that "there is no place like home."


