## **PASTORS CORNER**

Last Sabbath evening we held our annual church family meeting (CFM). For those who are unaware of the importance of a CFM, let me seek to educate the membership on the significance of this annual meeting. The CFM must be 'duly called' which means a verbal announcement by the Pastor or Elder, must be followed by a written notice, usually in the bulletin which states the time and place for the meeting. Every baptized member is allowed to attend and also have a voice in the meeting. Having a voice implies that a member can vote in support of a motion or vote against a motion. Every member has the right to share comments during the meeting when recognized by the chair of the meeting. The CFM is the highest decision-making body in the local church. The church board, which conducts the business of the church from month to month, is subservient to the decisions made at a CFM. Church board members are caretakers of the church on a monthly basis, but the membership as a whole represents the highest authority in the local church and every member has an equal vote regardless of age. The purpose of the CFM is to review minutes from the previous year's meeting, receive a membership update, hear reports from ministry leaders, share evangelistic plans, and vote a church budget for the new calendar year. Usually, the meeting lasts around two hours. These two hours will determine the course of ministry in the local church; therefore, attendance at the annual CFM is of utmost importance.

Upon review of the meeting, I was thankful for the turnout of around seventy people. I was impressed by the range of ages who were present, from young adult members to our seniors. I was equally thankful for the considerate and peaceful spirit which permeated our meeting. As ministry leaders shared their reports, my heart was warmed by the hours of sacrificial service that our members share in service for Jesus. Countless people in our church and community are being impacted because of untold hours of volunteer service by so many modern-day disciples of Jesus Christ. I will say. on a lighter note, that two minutes really seem to fly when sharing a report. Never fear, no one fell through a trap door if they exceeded their time allotment. The membership was super attentive as they listened to the various ministry reports. The membership accepted a church budget amount of \$350,000 for 2020. When I consider the amount needed to upkeep a building, support mission and ministry I am humbled and thankful for every member of College Park Church who faithfully gives. The membership also voted to pay an additional \$24,000 towards our church mortgage from a surplus of the 2019 church budget. Truly God is good! It is a privilege to be a Seventh-day Adventist member of College Park Church. As with all privileges, with this privilege comes responsibility; it is also our sacred responsibility to be active in mission, supportive in ministry, and choose daily to be a disciple of Jesus Christ.


