PASTORS CORNER

The events of last week from Sunday, September 1st until Sabbath, September 7th where almost apocalyptic in nature, except the four angels of Revelation did not hold back the prophetic winds of strife. While we as a congregation worshiped safely in the confines of our church's sanctuary, hurricane Dorian's week long path of destruction finally came close to an end. Beginning in the Bahamas and casually side stepping the eastern sea board of the United States Dorian finally reached its destructive conclusion in the Canadian Maritime Provinces. As I watched footage from ADRA Canada's appeal video last Sabbath, I could not but relive some of my childhood experiences of growing up on a little dot of an island in middle of the Atlantic Ocean where tropical storms and hurricanes were a regular seasonal occurrence. As a child, it seemed exciting to experience a raging hurricane. I looked forward to the proverbial quiet that accompanies the eye of the storm, and the missed days of school due to downed power lines and electrical power outages. As an adult, I now realize these catastrophes of nature bring no real happy moments, but memories of just how fragile life can be. I can recall candles and kerosene lamps; water being drawn from wells and nights that seemed to come ever so early. My fondest memory of surviving the hurricanes was the cleanup. It didn't matter who was at odds with who in the neighbourhood, when the cleanup began, everyone pitched in, everyone was neighbourly and the work ended when the last house on the street was attended to.

Hurricane Dorian which levelled the Northern Bahamas was recorded as a level five hurricane which means its winds reached speeds over 252km/h. One news report indicated that Dorian reached historical winds levels of up to 300km/h, the second strongest recorded speed since 1950. Level 5 hurricanes are noted for their catastrophic damage. Framed homes will be destroyed, with wall failure and collapsed roofing. Fallen trees and power poles will be scattered like tooth-picks and power outages could last from weeks to months. Most homes will be uninhabited for weeks or months depending on the response time of governments and the international community. Today we will collect a special offering for the survivors and cleanup efforts for hurricane Dorian. ADRA Canada has the experience in knowing who to partner with so that the funds we collect today will benefit as many people as possible. As stated above, a true neighbour is someone who helps others during times of difficulty. Someone who "shows up" when the need is great. My prayer today is that our College Park church family will "show up" in a BIG way for our neighbours far and near that were impacted by hurricane Dorian. God bless you as you give today!

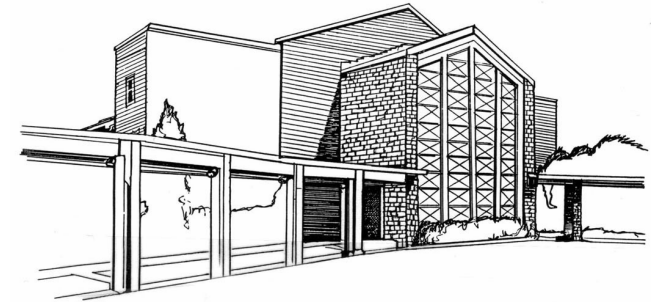
